

What is IRC?



Digital Inclusion Services:

IRC SLC launched the organization's first Digital Inclusion Program in 2017 and serves an average of 300 clients and their families per year.



Affordable Internet Access




We enroll all newly arrived families in Internet Essentials and the Affordable Connectivity Program.



Device Distribution

We provide one new or refurbished laptop and basic instruction on using the device to each family at arrival.



Tech Literacy Class

We host basic and intermediate digital skills classes each month by language group with an interpreter to ensure maximum understanding.

Virtual Reality (VR)

Program Outputs and Outcomes

- ◆ Affordable internet enrollment for 279 families since March 2023
- ◆ 422 devices distributed since August 2022
- ◆ DI classes have contributed to:
 - 27% in client's comfortability navigating a computer
 - 20% improvement in typing skills
 - 13% improvement in smart phone navigation and;
 - An 11% improvement in online safety awareness
